Context/background	<p>The Municipalities of Krusevo (North Macedonia) and Elbasan (Albania) cooperated on the IPA CBC Project "Krusevo and Elbasan – Acknowledged Cross-Border Tourist Destination" (Jan 2022 – Jun 2024), enhancing tourism infrastructure, creating a joint tourism package, and boosting marketing and local capacities. They aim to establish Krusevo and Elbasan as a top sustainable adventure tourism destination by leveraging cultural and natural assets. Krusevo, known for its cultural heritage and Meckin Kamen paragliding site, will host the World Paragliding Cup in 2026, while Elbasan is developing Funar Lakes for hiking, biking, and kayaking.</p> <p>The project addresses challenges like infrastructure gaps, skills development, marketing, and networking through integrated investments, training, and promotion to grow as a sustainable cross-border tourism destination.</p>
Abstract (short project summary)	<p>The project aims to promote sustainable tourism and economic growth in Krusevo and Elbasan by enhancing infrastructure, improving local capacities, and strengthening cross-border cooperation. Key developments include a paragliding site and sports field in Krusevo, and an adventure park and signposted paths in Elbasan, all aimed at attracting tourists and sports enthusiasts. Capacity-building activities will train local entrepreneurs in sustainable practices, while a cross-border network will foster collaboration among stakeholders through joint planning and marketing initiatives. Promotional efforts, such as social media and press campaigns, will boost regional visibility. The project is expected to improve tourism infrastructure, strengthen local stakeholder capacities, enhance cross-border collaboration, and increase regional visibility, benefiting residents, entrepreneurs, and providing sustainable economic growth.</p>
